I OBJECTIVES

- 1. To improve and maintain all roads to at least the existing standard.
- 2. To carry out maintenance and construction works in accordance with the Guidelines for Rural Roads Services within the limitations of the budget.

II POLICY STATEMENT

A. GUIDELINES FOR RURAL ROAD SERVICES

These Guidelines for Rural Road Services form Council's Access Policy as a guide to dedication, improvement and maintenance of the road network, recognising the need to distribute increasingly scarce financial resources in an orderly manner and any construction by Council take place after all landholders have been notified in writing of their obligations.

B. ROAD CLOSURES

- 1. The following conditions 2 and 3 are made as a guide only to intending applicants and to preserve the road network for future access.
- 2. Road reserves are to be retained to service the following agricultural activities at specified locations as nominated:

a)	Pastoral and dryland farming	2,000 ha
b)	Irrigation broadacre	400 ha
c)	Horticulture (between or fronting	
	Ellengerah Road and Wambianna Road	100 ha
d)	Rural Residential	10 ha

- 3. To provide continuity of access across a creek or river:
 - i. Existing road reserves at right angles to the river <u>and</u> lining up across the river should be retained;
 - ii. Applications adjoining a river or creek and more than 3 km from an existing crossing, the existing road or proposed road should be retained.

- 4. Land Parcels adjoining the road closure and denied legal access by the closure shall be tied by Restrictive Covenants to the Lot(s) created by road closure.
- 5. No objections being received from immediate neighbouring landholders.
- 6. Any requested variation to the road closure conditions is to be submitted for Council's determination.

NOTE:

Application for Road Closure must be made on Form CL31A-2 from the Department of Land and Water Conservation.

Council will not consider applications unless Page 4 CONSENT is completed showing adjoining landholders.
