FROM THE MAYOR'S DESK

Christmas spirit is now spreading across Warren Shire with the Community Christmas Tree now shining brightly in front of the Community Room. The countdown is on to the Warren Street Christmas Party to be held on the evening of Friday 8 December 2023. Both the Santa Street and the Business House Front Window Christmas Display Competitions are now underway.

I'm pleased to report that November saw the completion of the long awaited CBD and Lions Park amenities buildings collages. These mural designs were a community driven project and as such, I'd like to invite the community to the official opening ceremony taking place on Thursday 7 December 2023 at Lions Park.

A number of projects across our Shire have progressed in recent weeks, including the impressive reconstruction of the Dragon Cowal Causeway after significant flood damage, completion of the Five Mile Cowal Bridge Rehab Project, and improved drainage works at the intersection of the Old Warren Road and the Industrial Access Road.



Additionally, new amenities were constructed at Monkeygar Creek, with a bird viewing platform soon to follow.

And finally, I'd like to again remind residents that nominations for the Warren Shire Australia Day Awards are open. If you know someone you'd like to see recognised, then I highly recommend you submit a nomination. It is important for us to recognise those who contribute to our community.

MORE MAGNIFICENT MURALS

In exciting news, the highly anticipated mural wraps have officially been installed on the CBD and Lions Park toilet amenities. Both collage designs were derived from image submissions from our community and curated by Signarama to create these fantastic Warren Shire and Macquarie River themed collage vinyl wraps.

Funding for these projects came from restricted funds for infrastructure improvement/replacement (\$192,000), Aubrey Dinsdale's bequeath to Council (\$52,813.78), the Murray Darling Basin Economic Development – Improvement of Regional Structures Grant (\$24,500), Warren Lions Club (\$16,000), and the Drought Communities Extension Program (\$129,789).

The official opening of these murals will be held at Lions Park at 1pm on Thursday 7 December 2023.

WORKS IN WARREN SHIRE

Works in Warren Shire continue to forge ahead as we near the end of the year, with recent developments including the completion of construction on both the Dragon Cowal Causeway and the Five Mile Cowal Bridge Rehab Project, as well as Old Warren Road and Industrial Access Road intersection drainage works.

A new toilet building has also been recently built at Monkeygar Creek, Macquarie Marshes, following approval of a Development Application for the construction of a bird viewing platform and amenities.
