ROADS UPDATE

Bitumen maintenance works have been undertaken on:

- Warren streets
- Carinda Road
- Warren Road
- Marthaguy Road
- Nevertire Bogan Road
- Tottenham Road.

Maintenance grading works have been carried out on:

- Yungundi Road
- Merrigal Road
- Catons Road
- Canonba Road
- Pigeonbah Lane
- Wonbobbie Lane
- Nellievale Road
- Ellerslie Road
- And patches of Gradgery Lane.

An attempt has been made to repair the badly damaged section of the Warren Road (Segment 14) located about 14km north of its intersection with the Marthaguy Road. The repair will involve the addition of road base, a lime stabilisation treatment and the application of a new bitumen seal.

WARREN WAR MEMORIAL SWIMMING POOL

The Warren War Memorial Swimming Pool is scheduled to open in mid-October.

An extensive amount of work has been undertaken over the off season with new filtration, shade structures, replacement of pool piping, electrical works, new irrigation, turf and main pool fibreglass works and painting.

Unfortunately, the pool painting is not complete, resulting in the delay to the opening.
